MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: GRANT OF DEARNESS ALLOWANCE TO THE STATE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AND FURTHER AD-HOC INCREASE IN THE WAGES OF DAILY RATED WORKERS UNDER THE GOVERNMENT WITH EFFECT FROM JANUARY 01, 2015.

The Governor is pleased to decide that the whole time State Government Employees drawing basic pay (i.e Band Pay + Grade Pay, NPA, if any) up to Rs. 80,000/- shall draw Dearness Allowance @ 65% with effect from 1st January, 2015. The calculation of Dearness Allowance shall be made taking into account the revised Band Pay, Grade Pay & NPA , if any , but shall not include any other types of Pay.

2) The Dearness Allowance sanctioned herein above shall be rounded off to the nearest rupee in each case.

3) The Governor has also been pleased to decide that there will be a further ad-hoc increase in the existing daily rate of wages by Rs. 15/- (Rupees fifteen) only with effect from January 01, 2015 for the daily rated workers under the Government whose wages are not regulated by any statutory provisions like the Minimum Wages Act, etc.

Subject : Grant of Dearness Allowance to the State Government Employees/ Teachers and Non-Teaching Employees of Non-Government Educational Institutions / Employees of Statutory Bodies / Government Undertakings / Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee and Municipal Corporation / Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. who are drawing their pay in the pre-revised scale with effect from January 01, 2015.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's Order No. 8840-F(P2) dated 16-12-2013 revising the Dearness Allowance with effect from 01-01-2014 in respect of the State Government Employees/ Teachers and Non-Teaching Employees of Non-Government Educational Institutions / Employees of Statutory Bodies / Government Undertakings / Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee and Municipal Corporation / Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. who are drawing their pay in the pre-revised scale of pay.

The rates of Dearness Allowance to above categories of employees shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 127% to 139% with effect from 01-01-2015. All other conditions as laid down in 10902-F(P) dated 09-12-2009 will continue to apply.

The Dearness Allowance sanctioned hereinabove shall be rounded off to the nearest rupee in each case.

It has also been decided that in the case of Public Undertaking / Statutory Bodies the additional expenditure should be borne by such Undertakings / Bodies themselves out of their own resources or out of financial assistance provided to them in the budget and that no additional financial assistance will be given to them on account of sanction of Dearness Allowance.

Subject : Grant of Dearness Allowance to the Teachers and Non-Teaching Employees of Non -Government Educational Institutions / Employees of Statutory Bodies / Government Undertakings / Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee and Municipal Corporation / Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. with effect from January 01, 2015.

Sir,

It has been decided to revise the rate of Dearness Allowance admissible to the State Government Employees with effect from January 01, 2015 vide Finance Department's Memo No. 143-F (P2) dated 09-01-2015 copy of which is enclosed for ready reference.

2. This benefit of Dearness Allowance, as has been sanctioned in the aforesaid Memorandum for the State Government Employees, will also be allowed to the Teachers and Non-Teaching Employees of Non-Government Educational Institutions / Employees of Statutory Bodies / Government Undertakings / Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee and Municipal Corporation/ Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. who are in receipt of Dearness Allowance at State Government rates i.e 58% of Band Pay and Grade pay taken together with effect from January 01, 2014.

3. The respective Administrative Department may sanction the benefit of Dearness Allowance @65% with effect from January 01, 2015 to the Employees concerned under their control in terms of Finance Department's Memo No. 143-F(P2) Dated-09-01-2015 without making any further reference to Group 'P2' of this Department.

4. It has also been decided that in the case of Public Undertaking / Statutory Bodies the additional expenditure should be borne by such Undertakings / Bodies themselves out of their own resources or out of financial assistance provided to them in the budget and that no additional financial assistance will be given to them on account of sanction of Dearness Allowance.
