No. 866/ MA/O/C-4/1A-20/2017

Dated: 27th December, 2017

WHEREAS Government of West Bengal has initiated a unique scheme, namely 'Green City Mission' which aims for sustainable and eco friendly Green and Clean Cities and planned development of all 125 Municipal cities and towns of West Bengal.

AND, WHEREAS, projects under Green City Mission are being implemented successfully throughout entire state to make the cities environment friendly, sustainable, resilient, energy positive and to provide citizen friendly services in a better way.

AND, WHEREAS a good number of policy makers, corporate leaders from around the globe, delegations, academia, opinion makers often visit Kolkata as the State Capital

AND, WHEREAS The Department has already notified vide order No.626/ MA/O/C-4/1A-20 /2017 dated: 15th September, 2017, the area surrounding the Stadium and the Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose International Airport and surrounding areas from Airport, Jessore Road side to the stadium along with Biswa Bangla Sarani and EM bypass upto Parama Island as 'Green Zone' and declared the guideline to keep the zone clean and beautiful and it attracted sheer acclaim from all corners.


AND, WHEREAS it has been felt that **besides the above areas, Airport to Chinar park via Kaji Najrul Islam Sarani , Major arterial Road, Parama island to Nabanna via MAA Fly Over & AJC Bose Fly over , from Nabanna to New Alipore through Alipore Road, Red Road area** (hereinafter referred as the said areas) will be kept clean and beautiful to make the city of Kolkata more eco friendly and attractive.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby declared that the said areas shall be treated as '**Green Zone**' and the concerned Urban Local Bodies/Development Authorities shall ensure compliance of the following guidelines within their respective jurisdiction, accordingly:

Guidelines for maintenance of 'Green Zone'

1. The Urban Local Bodies /Development Authorities shall make special effort for cleaning of garbage, debris etc. along the roadside and in and around the venue in a periodic manner during the period. They shall also ensure that no building materials has been stacked or disposed of in the road side by anyone.

2. All major roads within the jurisdiction of the Urban Local Body connecting the said areas should be well maintained to make it smooth and hump-free and sufficiently illuminated by roadside lighting system. There should be cleaning of roads /streets twice daily.
3. ULBs/Development Authorities has to maintain footpath, service lanes, drains & medians in good conditions and take steps for beautification of the areas.
4. Placement of roadside bins should properly be done. Stacking of building materials beside roads will not be allowed. Open burring of disposable articles is also to be prohibited.
5. For the purpose of security and safety of the citizens & visitors, CCTV surveillance system should be properly maintained.
6. No hoardings/ publicity material will be displayed in this 'Green Zone' without the consent of the competent authority. Information Education and Communication materials which manifest the essence of 'Green Zone' are to be displayed at befitting places.


