WHEREAS in the opinion of the Governor, it is necessary to constitute an industrial township under section 385A of the West Bengal Municipal Act, 1993 (West Ben. Act XXII of 1993) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), comprising areas in and around Bengal Aerotropolis Project Limited Airport City Project in the district of Burdwan, specified in the Schedule below (hereinafter referred to as the said areas) for the purpose of making provisions of all or any of the provision of the said Act, in respect of the said areas where the industries have been or are being established;

AND WHEREAS notification being 02/MA/O/C-4/1M-40/2014, dated the 2nd January, 2015, of this Department was published in the *Kolkata Gazette Extraordinary*, dated the 5th January, 2015 (hereinafter referred to as the said notification) declaring the intention of the Governor to constitute the industrial township;

AND WHEREAS the period of three months, from the date of publication of the said notification, for submitting objection or suggestion has expired and no objection or suggestion has been received during the said period of three months;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (3) of section 385A of the said Act, the Governor is pleased hereby to constitute an industrial township namely "Golden City Industrial Township" in the district of Burdwan comprising the said area more fully described in the Schedule below:—
